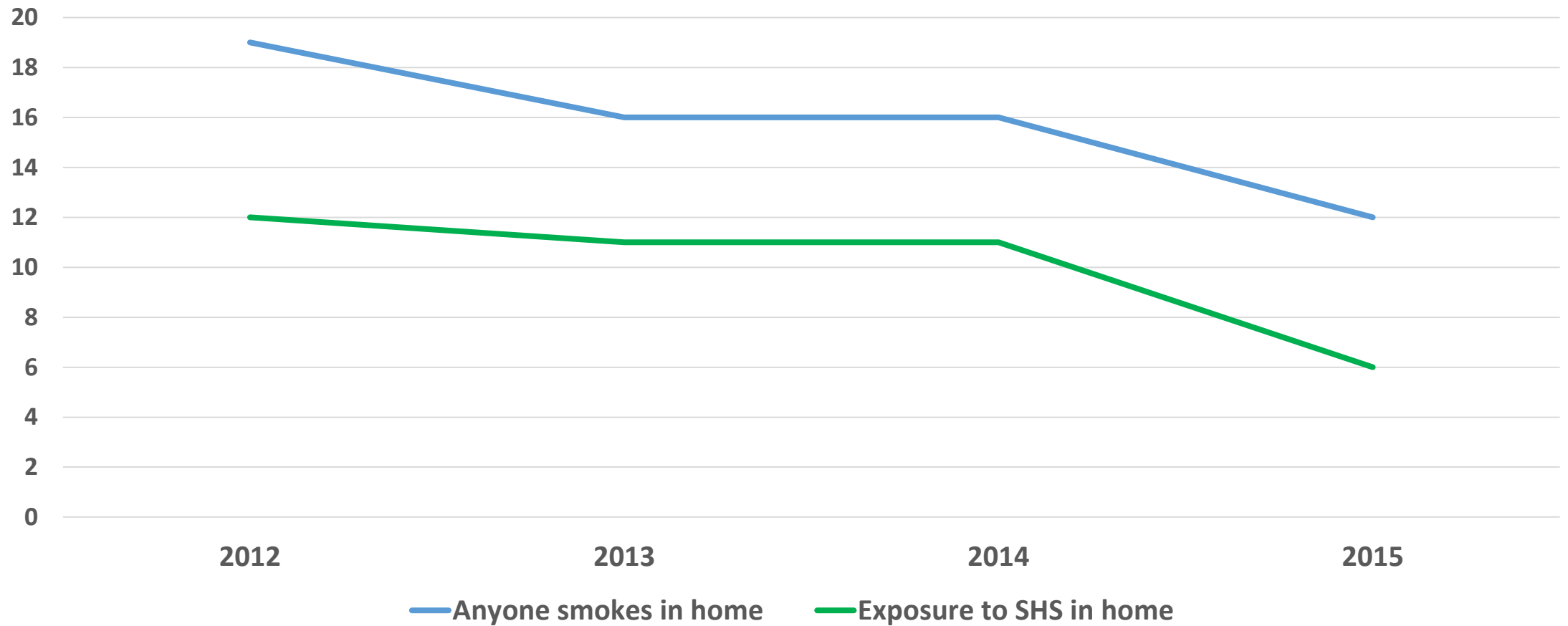

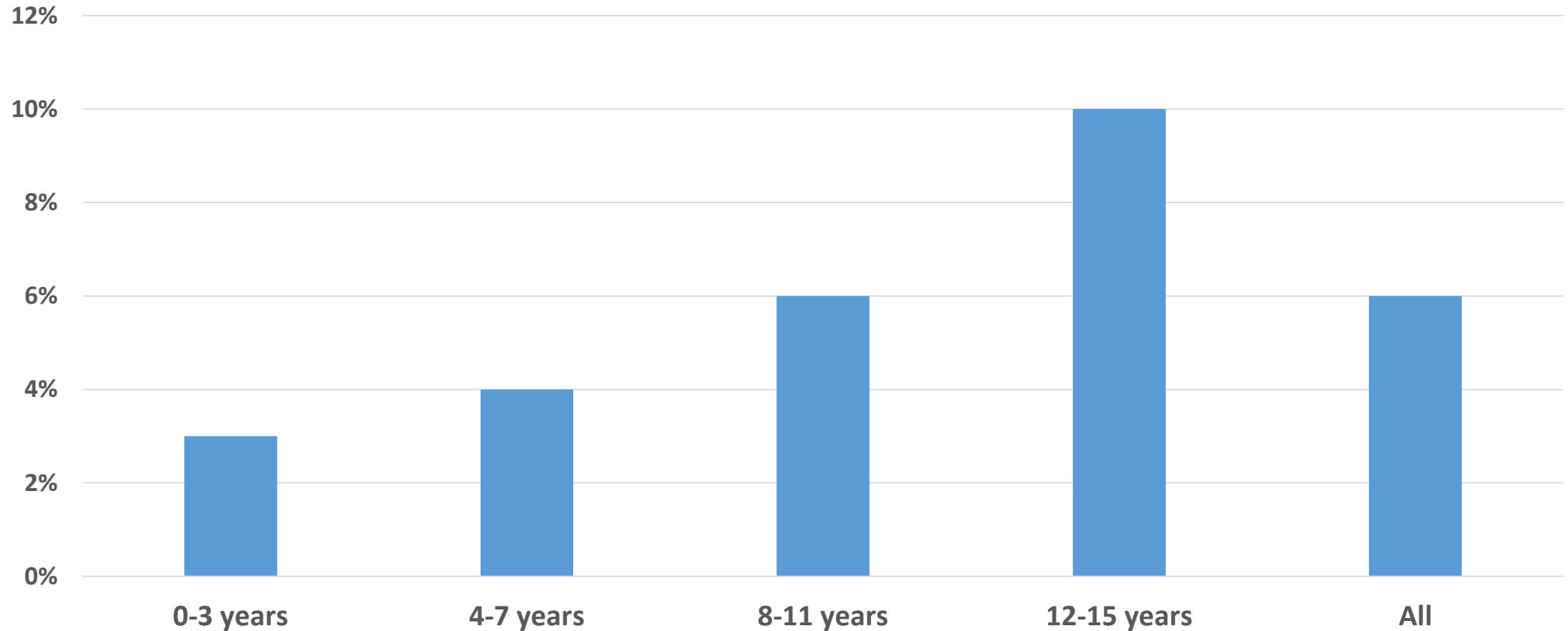

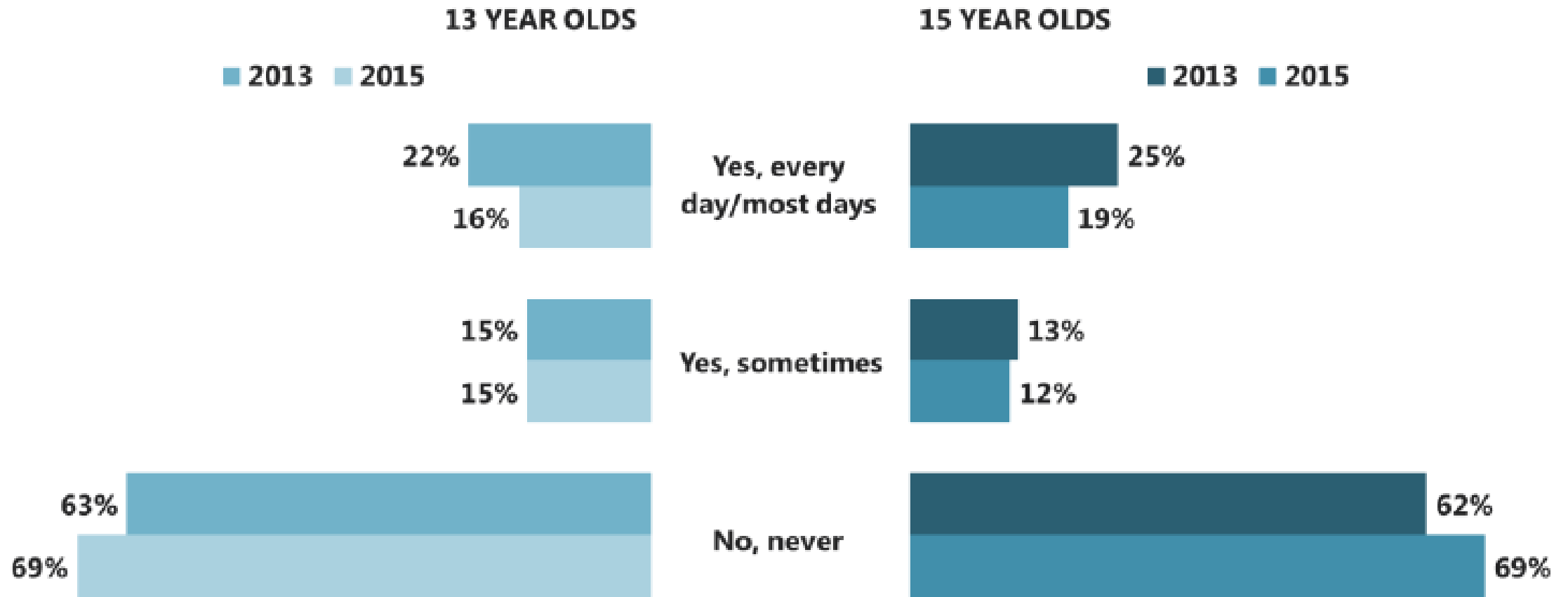


# Children ever exposed to SHS in the home by age (SHeS 2015)



### Figure 5.3 Exposure to smoke at home, by age and year (2013-2015)

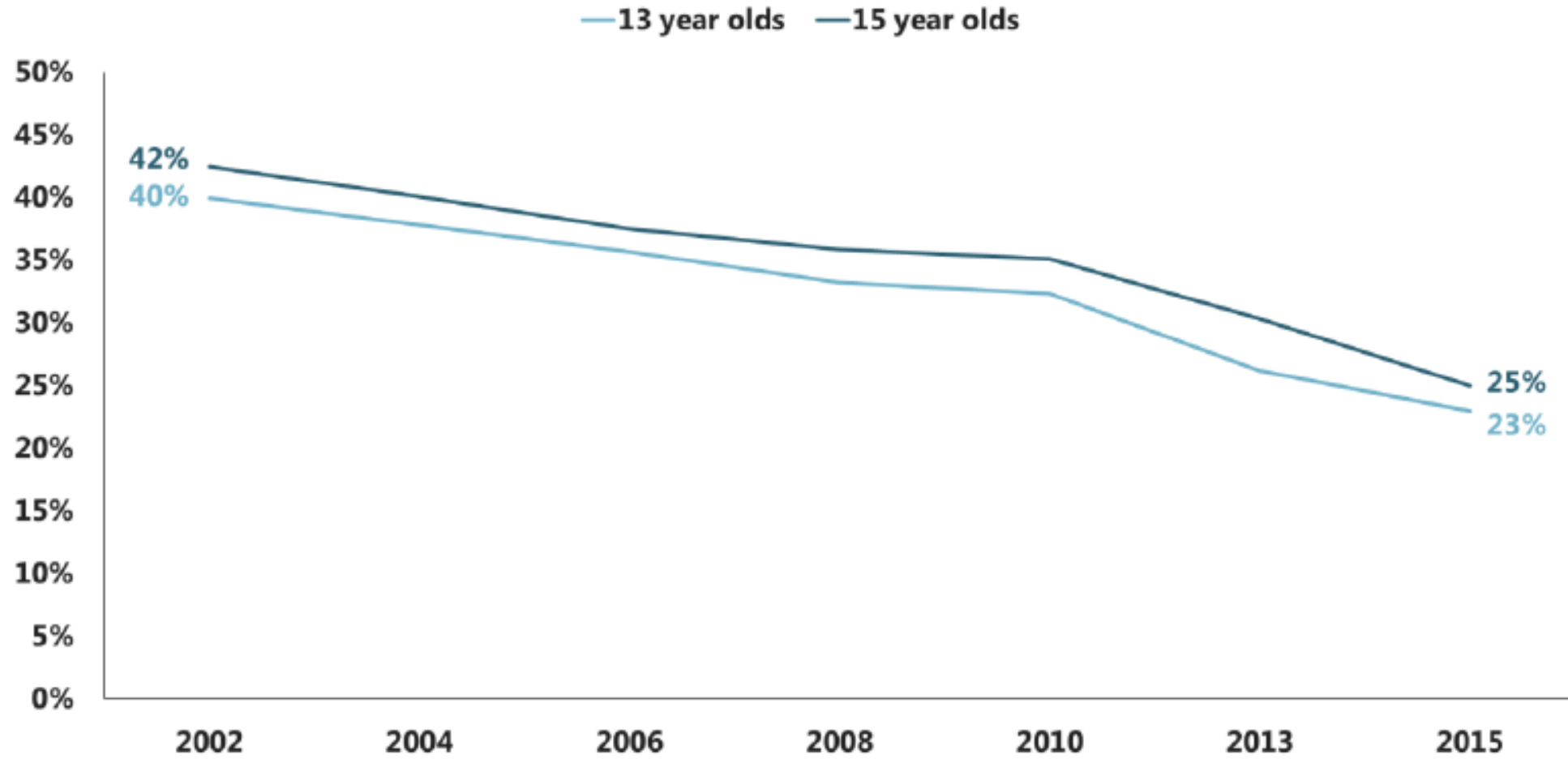

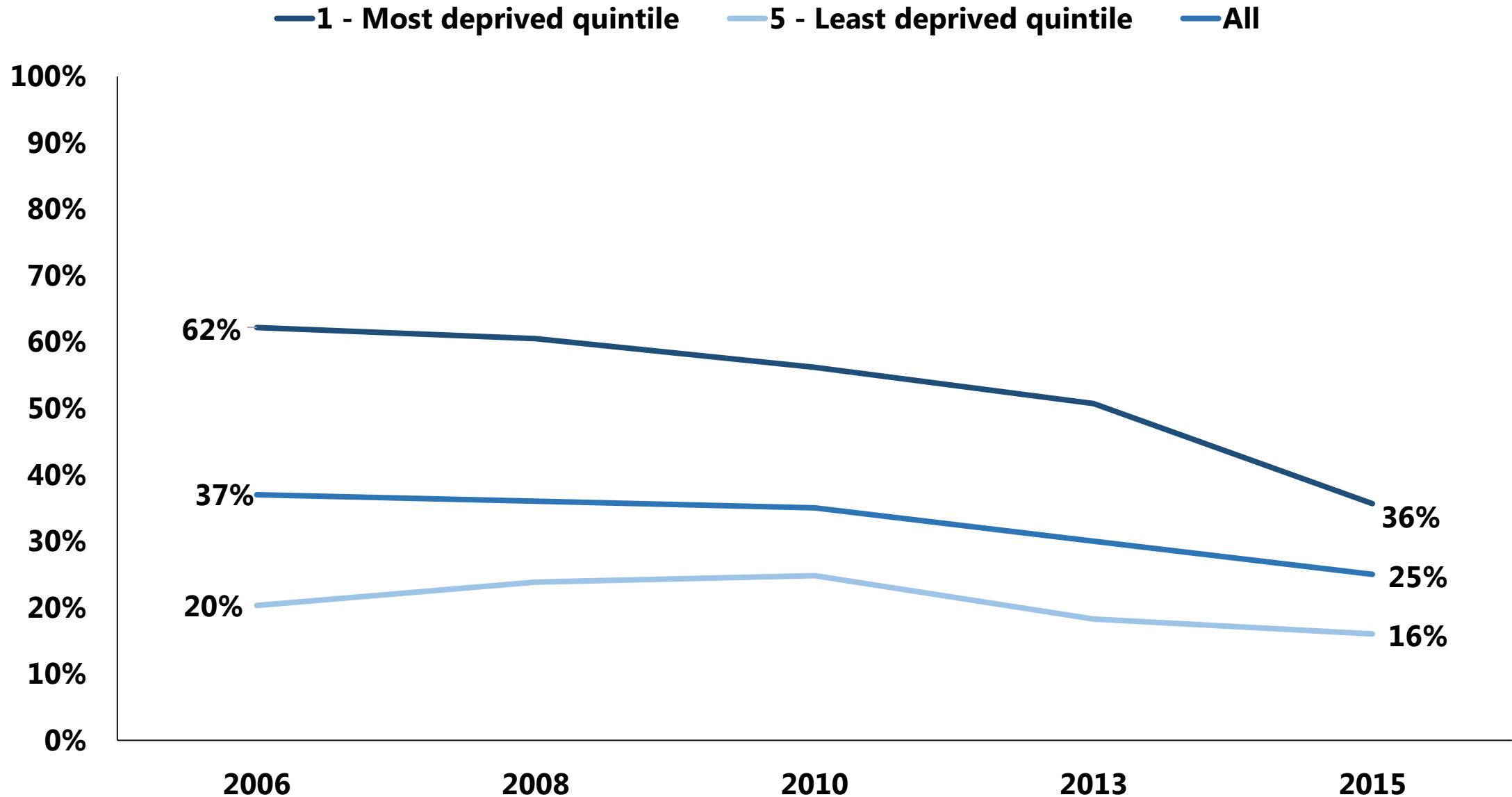
**Figure 5.6 Trends in proportion of pupils with at least one parent who smokes daily, by age (2002-2015)**

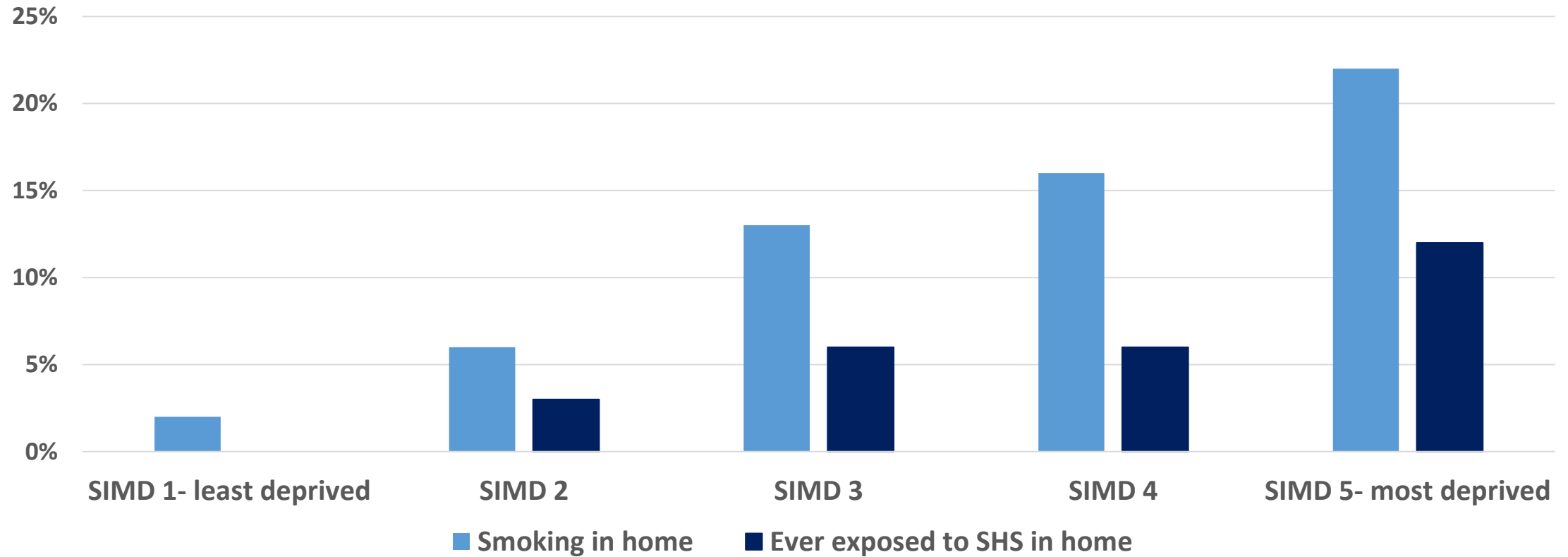

Exposed to smoke at home:				
Adult non-smokers	4%	2%	18%	10%
Children	1%	<1%	22%	12%
Rules in home- can smoke anywhere /certain rooms:				
Adults	13%	5%	43%	24%
Children	4%	0%	33%	24%
